is a joint project of the German seaports. German Ports provides you with container and vessel information for all the major German seaports (Hamburg, Bremerhaven and Wilhelmshaven) in a standardized form and covering all locations.

Digital Release Order

German Ports lays the groundwork for a fully digitalized release process. As a forwarder or importer, you send your release request to German Ports and, as soon as release information is available, you will receive it instantly – including the release reference, return depot for empty containers, and the corresponding Turn-In Reference.



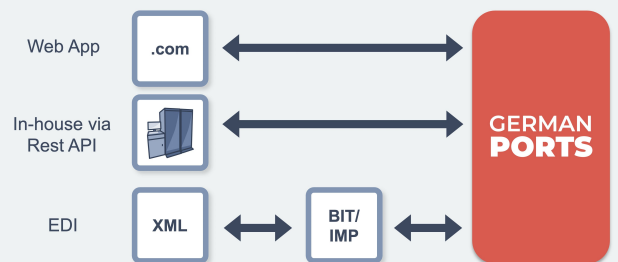
As a shipping company, you can also receive requests via the platform. You transmit the release information and return depot specifications to the platform using your own format. In its function as an integration platform, German Ports converts the data into a standardized format and ensures that it is forwarded to authorised participants.



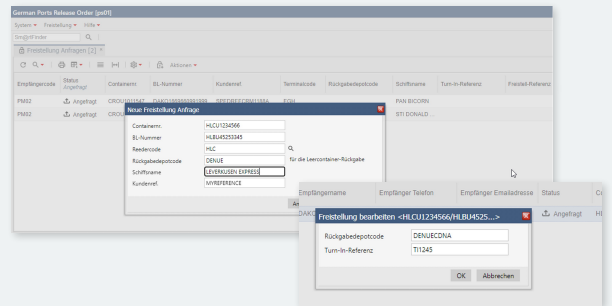
